

KAG Wood Smoke Reduction Program Rebate Eligibility

- Applicants must reside in the legal dwelling unit on property located within the Kitimat-Terrace Valley airshed, which includes (but is not limited to) homes within Kitimat, Kitamaat Village, Kitselas Nation, Thornhill, Lakelse Lake, Terrace, Gitga'at Nation, Kitsumkalum, Laxgalts'ap Village Government, Hartley Bay, and Rosswood. Contact KAG if you are unsure if your residence is eligible. The registered property owner must support the application.
- You must replace a functioning wood stove appliance (wood stove, wood furnace, wood insert with airtight doors, barrel stove or homemade stove) manufactured in 2017 or earlier, which was regularly used as the home's primary heating source with an EPA-certified wood stove, pellet stove, or electric air-source heat pump. Heat pumps must be a qualifying product through CleanBC
- The wood-burning appliance must be removed, decommissioned and recycled (i.e. it cannot be re-used in a workshop or garage).
- Before replacing the existing wood stove, all applicants must contact the Kitimat Airshed Group to confirm their eligibility. Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funding lasts. Applicants are advised to submit their application once their project is complete.

Required Documents

- Copy of dated sales and installation receipt (originals not needed as they will not be returned) indicating brand, model name, model number, and the appliance's serial number.
- Copy of AHRI number or certificate.
- Recent photographs of functioning previous wood stove (i.e. before removal), including make, model and serial number specifications plate on the back of the stove. (Picture acceptable)
- Photograph of the newly installed appliance.
- Confirmation of decommissioning of the old stove:
 - Rendered non-usable by the retailer (i.e. doors removed, recycled, etc.) or

Application Submissions

- The online application and all attachments must be submitted through the KAG's website or contact KAG for a PDF application.

Rebate Cheques

- Rebate cheques will be mailed out to the participant/homeowner within six weeks of receiving their completed application. **Incomplete information that is submitted, missing documents, or non-eligibility for the Program will delay or void the issuing of your rebate.**
